\$30 1st Year Coaches-must include copy of Drivers license and copy of Coaches Certification Testing results

\$25 2nd-7th Year Coaches-do not need copy of drivers' license if already on file only need Coaches Certification Testing Results

\$25 Signed Championship Roster

\$10 Team Volunteer-includes background check and insurance

**Safety Bases are Mandatory through CCGSA:** Area Heads check with you association on to make sure all fields that have 8U and older girls' playing have a regulation safety base in use. If any location does not have regulation safety base at game time the game will be postponed to a later date when a regulation safety base has been installed.

**Regulation Pitching Rubbers:** All pitching rubbers are to be 6"X24" and flush with the ground if no pitching rubber game will be rescheduled
